

As attested to during the July 29, 2026, Senate Business and Commerce hearings on Electric Grid and 765kV Transmission Lines the Public Utility Commission of Texas exceeded the directives of the 2023 HB 5066 bill and FAILED:

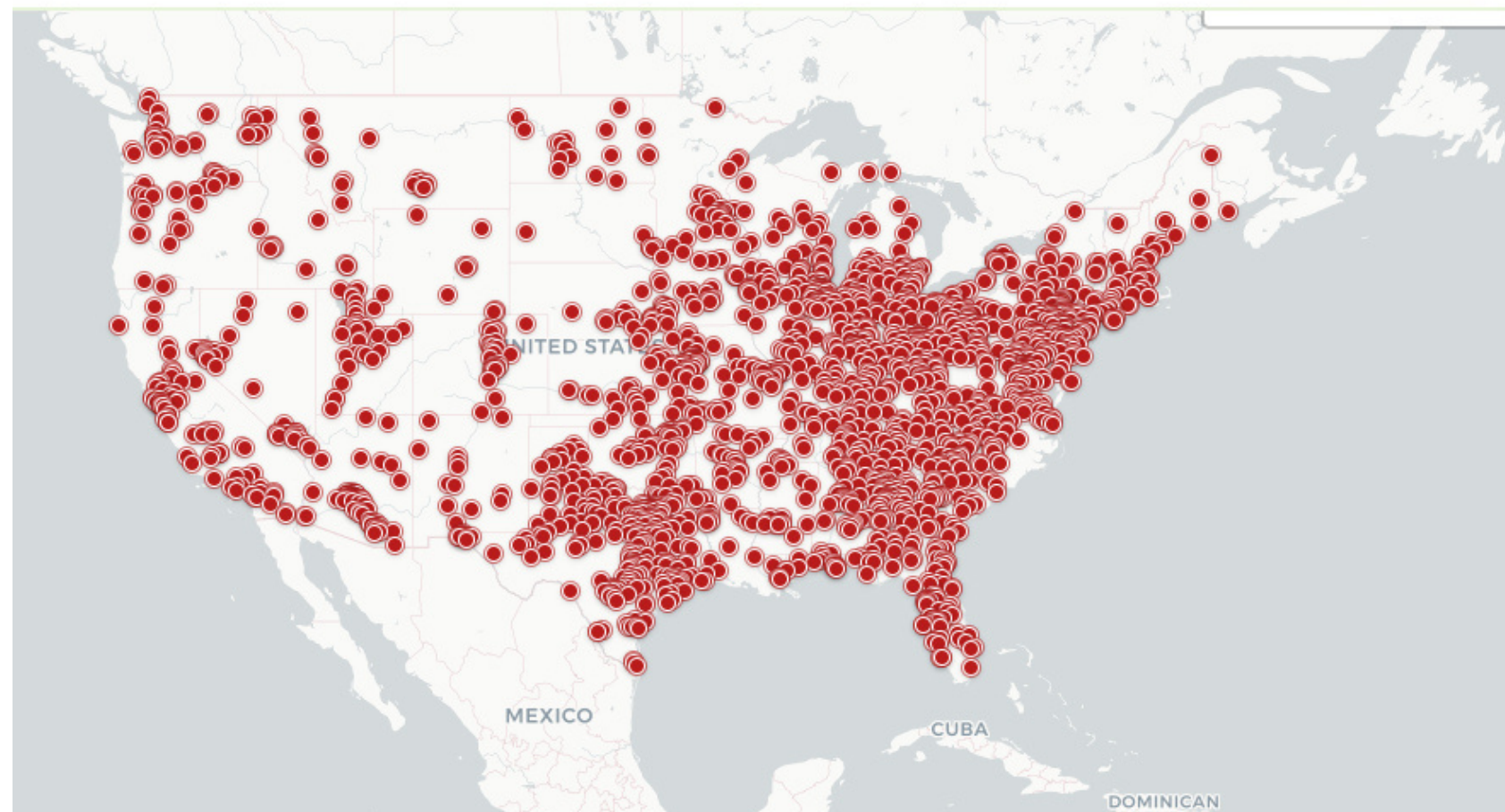
- to provide proper notification with equal notice to all landowners, with many landowners reporting no notices at all, while some had one year notice and others only had 30 days.
- to provide proper due process for landowners to seek legal assistance to participate as interveners at State Office of Administrative Hearings (SOAH),
- to provide opportunity to seek legal council to participate in SOAH by allowing them to amend their applications to remain in the case -700-800 applicants were struck from the proceedings,
- to give notifications when new lines were drawn, failed to properly designate buildings that were home dwellings or barns since assessments done via aerial views and not boots on the ground.

This committee received notice of public endangerment that there is a 1800 ft “blast” zone of electromagnetic fields that show increase in leukemia and dementia of residents within that zone.

The taking of property without due process and equal opportunity for representation are a Constitutional Violations. Each official, Governor, Lt. Governor, Senator, and Representative who knowingly and willingly refuses to take action are violating their oath of office.
