



Regarding for "The River to the Sea", the Palestinian chant is "From the River to Sea, Palestine will be free" while Israel's chant is "From the River to the Sea, one state, Israel". So who wants to be rid of who?

It also goes back to July 2013, with comments from Uri Ariel who was later appointed Minister of Agriculture and Rural Development said, "We need to state clearly that there won't be a Palestinian state west of the Jordan River."[13] In 2014 he said "Between the Jordan River and the Mediterranean Sea there will be only one state, which is Israel". [14] In January 2016, he called on the government to annex Area C of the West Bank during a tour of the West Bank led by the Knesset Land for Israel Caucus.

Depicted below is Netanyahu at the United Nations on September 26, 2023 with the map, showing the "New Middle East", yet the map shows no presence of Palestine. "The war began on Oct. 7, 2023 when Hamas militants stormed across the border into Israeli communities. Israel says the militants killed more than 1,200 people, mostly civilians, and took some 250 people into captivity in Gaza. A new list released by the Palestinian Ministry of Health that includes the names, age and gender of those killed up until March 22 includes 50,021 people, ranging from a newborn baby to a 110-year-old. Of those, 15,613 or 31% were under 18," per Reuters. The lack of Israel's security and defense response to the October 7th Hamas attack is coming into serious question by IDF soldiers and the Israeli people and many other countries.
